God. This may sound like mere Theology? But it is not, it is just the key to the meaning of life, and what "we" have illusions and delusions of what is mistakenly called life. The first and most essential truth that we must grasp is that no created being has the life in himself. Creatures are created to contain the life, not to be it in themselves: the essence of idolatry is to claim to be what only God is. God is God, and there are not Gods beside Him. God can

Man must never forget, in trying to place himself on the same level as God, or set himself up as a god, altho he may be fooled in his own little liquid brain that he has the attributes of God. He may be thinking, feeling, willing being, a spirit clothed in soul and body. In every sense he is like God, made int he image of God. But he is not God. He is only a vessel or a container, really nothing, but a human self.
