
Whatever the days

Religion has always been "popular" in this old world, but "Christianity" has never been.

Do YOU KNOW the difference?

Think: If any man among you SEEM to BE religious and bridleth NOT his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's Religion Is In Vain. (King James version of James I:26) Then Apostle James went on to EXPLAIN one of the view points of this subject.

Quote James 1:27 — Pure Religion and undefiled BEFORE God and the Father IS THIS. To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction and to keep himself unspotted from the world. (But how in this chaotic world can we now!)

Think: James had just written in verse 25 just before these words, this divisible with LIBERTY and Justice for — Say! Do You KNOW or guess at the words of our Bible and our constitution decree?

Think back: Apostle Paul speaking (King James version) Acts 17:22,23 "Then Paul stood up in the midst of Mars' Hill and said, Ye men of Athens, I perceive that in all things you are too superstitious.

Notice in King James version the word "superstitious" was used, yet in the New International version AND the Revised Standard version AND the Living New Testament version AND the Amplified New **Testament AND perhaps** other versions, the word **RELIGION** was used. But notice in all those versions, in verse 23 Paul said — TO THE UNKNOWN GOD speaking of worship and beliefs of people. What is YOUR

religion?

The word "Christian" is found three times in our Bible — Acts 11:26, Acts 26:28 and I Peter 4:16.
