A hearing on whether comedian Redd Foxx has to continue paying his wife \$2,500 monthly on temporary support pending their divorce has been postponed in District Court until July 22

**District Court Judge** Joe Pavlikowski granted the continuance last week, but ordered Foxx to supply a financial statement by the next court date.

Foxx contends that Joi Yun Chi Foxx is able to support herself and that he could no longer afford to make the payments.

Foxx, 58, filed for divorce in Las Vegas on Oct. 23, 1979, charging incompatibility, and Mrs. Foxx, 37, countered with

### her own divorce suit in Los Angeles on Oct. 31, 1979, charing cruelty.

The second of two **Operation Life child care** centers in North Las Vegas closed Tuesday, because their federal landlord has decided to sell the buildings.

Operation Life, a nonprofit community service organization, has been operating the day care centers for low-income families since 1974. **Ruby Duncan, Executive** Director of the organization, said **Operation Life was** recently notified by the federal Department of Housing and Urban **Development that the** two centers would have to relocate.

Five paid staff members will lose their jobs asaresultofthe closing, Duncan said.


