CCCC THEATRE

It's a little unusual, but it's not the first time the Clark County Community College's Little Theatre will play host to another theatre group.

When asked why CCC was willing to take an outside theatre group under their wing, so to speak, Theatre Arts Specialist Bob Dunkerly said, "A theatre's responsibility is to stimulate their audiences." He credits the local drama company Theatre Exposed, now in rehearsal for their second guest production at the college, for producing the kind of plays that do just that.

Theatre Exposed received rave reviews last season for their production of David Rabe's poignant play "Streamers" presented at CCC.

"On July 23, they'll open in the CCCC Little Theatre with two one-act plays by David Mamet, "Perversity In Chicago" and "The Duck Variations."

CCCC Henderson

Ahead of schedule, the new Henderson campus of the Clark County Community College will be staffed and equipped to welcome what college administrators feel will be the largest enrollment in the facility's nine years of operation.

The Henderson Campus opened in 1972 for 125 students using rented classrooms at St. Peter's Roman Catholic Church on Boulder Highway. In 1975, eleven new courses were added, and the enrollment increased to 162 students.

In September, 1981, an enrollment of 1,000 is expected to use the new \$1.9 million dollar facility on an 80 acre site off Horizon Drive at Mosswood, in the heart of residential Henderson.

The instructors include Arnold Friedman (Electronics), Jim Stacey (Welding), Mel Pedras (Drafting), and Bob Lyle (Aircraft Main-

tenance). The position of an instructor for Ornamental Horticulture is still open.

Registration for Fall classes will take place on August 19 and 20, at the new campus, from 2 to 8 p.m.

CCCC NURSES

The shortage of nurses in Clark County has led to a decision to enlarge the program for Licensed Practical Nurses at Clark County Community College. Men and women who wish to enter the field of nursing are asked to apply to the college immediately.

The course in Licensed Practical Nursing at CCCC is the only program offered to future practical nurses in Southern Nevada and the college program is rated above the national average in standards.
