ture of a bird safely nestled on its nest amid the raging winds of a mighty storm.

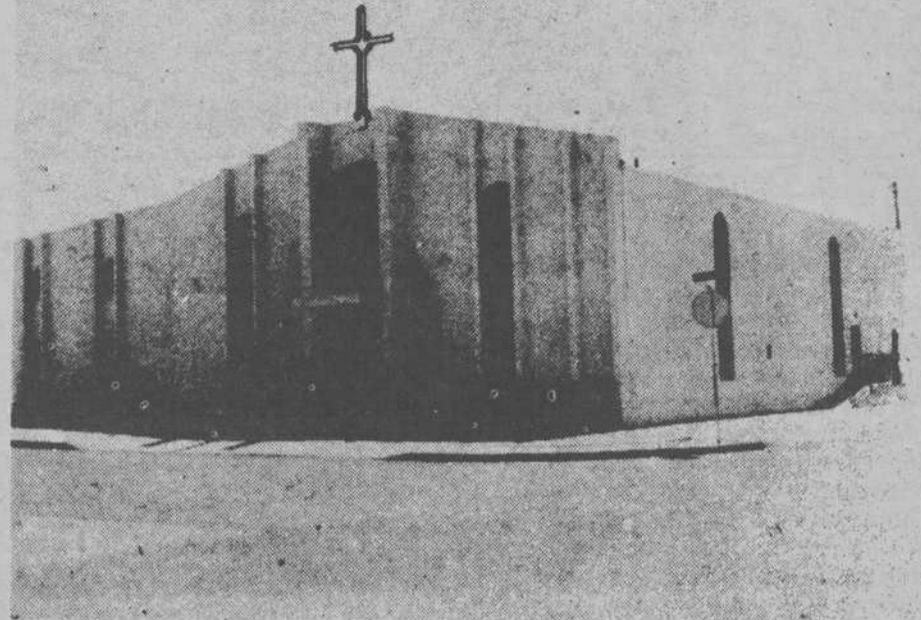

## Love All People

The Love All People singing group will embark on their third annual tour next week. The group, under the direction of its current leader and founder, Rev. Prentice Minner, is scheduled to perform in Los Angeles, St. Louis, Chicago, and Indianapolis for church groups, juvenile centers and other civic organizations.

The group of nine teenagers, who were formerly strung out on drugs & having trouble in school with countless social and emotional problems, was formed several years ago by Minner, who began to teach them music. Since that time the group has made significant strides within the Las Vegas

community. Some of the members have re-enrolled in school and the group has a nearly 100 percent success rate in redirecting the lives of these teenagers.

Love All People performs all over the country for hospitals, churches, teenage and civic organizations. They have also performed in several hotel showrooms and appeared on the Jerry Lewis Telethon for Muscular Dystrophy.

The juvenile authorities in England have recently asked to study the group and its program. They will be sending an English juvenile officer to Las Vegas to spend a week with the Love All People group sometime in September.
