OPERATION LIFE IS ONE OF THE KEY LOCATIONS AND WILL BE HELD IN THAT SITE ONE DAY ONLY — OCT. 9 FROM 9 A.M. TO 5 P.M.

Health Fair '81 is now underway according to Curt Fenske, Project Director of this year's health fair. The event began on Oct. 3 at three different sites in the Las Vegas area and will end on October 12. There were 13 separate sites in Las Vegas and surrounding area.

Operation Life is one of the key locations and will be held in that site one day only- Oct 9 from 0 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Chevron U.S.A., and KTNV Channel 13 are major sponsors with First Interstate Bank, Summa Corporation, Caesar's Palace, MGM Grand Hotel, Southwest Gas, Centel, and the Dunes Hotel as additional sponsors.

The Health Fair is an excellent way to have blood pressure, height and weight, vision and anemia screening, in addition to free counseling and referral. For a nominal fee of \$7.00,

participants may have blood chemistry work done for cholesterol, diabetes, liver and kidney functions plus 20 other blood chemistries. A 6-hour fast is required for this test. Pap smears are included at Operation Life.

The purpose of the Health Fair is to promote the concept of health awareness and preventative health care and to also supply testing to people who may otherwise not be able to afford such services.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

This health fair is meant to help you maintain your good health; it is not a comprehensive medical evaluation and cannot replace a good medical evaluation by your physician or health care provider.

IF YOUR RESULTS ARE NORMAL, this is good, but it does not mean that a physical examination or a repeat evaluation could not detect something abnormal. It also is not a guarantee that you are in perfect health.

IF YOUR RESULTS ARE OUTSIDE NORMAL LIMITS, this does not necessarily mean something is wrong. Abnormal results may be peculiar to something about the screening, for example, you weren't fasting or were very anxious, or to some variation in the laboratory. When you receive your screening results in the mail, all tests marked for further evaluation should be rechecked by your physician or health care provider because they may indicate the first signs of serious problems which, if treated promptly, could avoid permanent damage, long illness, and great expense.

Your health is **your** responsibility. We can help you in making wise choices about maintaining your health. We hope we have helped you by identifying those parts of your lifestyle which support your good health and those which increase the possibility for trouble in the future. Only you can use these suggestions to maintain your health.
