### NATIONAL EDUCATION WEEK, Nov. 15-21

The Clark County School District Superintendent of Schools, Charles A. Silvestri, will officiate at ceremonies honoring Clark County's 1981 National Merit Scholarship Semifinalists and their parents to culminate a week-long observance of National Education Week, Nov. 15-21.

The Superintendent's ceremony, which will be held in the Education Center Broad Room on Nov. 20 at 4 p.m., will recognize the students' academic excellence and educational achievements. Following the ceremony, a reception will be held in the cafeteria.

American Education Week, first established

in the United States in 1921 to acquaint the public with the workings of education, its problems, achievements and needs, will be sponsored locally by the American Education Week Coalition.

### CCSD Selected For Forum At UCLA

Dr. Theron Swainston, Associate Superintendent of the Clark County School District, has been selected by the UCLA Graduate School of Education to make a presentation at its upcoming conference. CCSD, selected as one of two exemplary districts in the United States, will be represented by Swainston at the Nov. 5 and 6 conference which will focus on the appropriate linking of testing and evaluation with the overall instructional program.

Prior to the selection, teams of researchers were sent to selected school districts throughout the country to interview school per-

sonnel and to directly observe instructional and evaluation programs.

Those invited to attend the conference include representatives from 15 selected school districts across the country and research and evaluation personnel from universities.

Presentations also will be made by a representative of the Cincinnati School District, the director of the National Center for the Improvement of Learning, the director of the Huron Institute, the project directors and staff from the center for the Study of Evaluation, and Dr. James Proham, well known professor of education at UCLA.

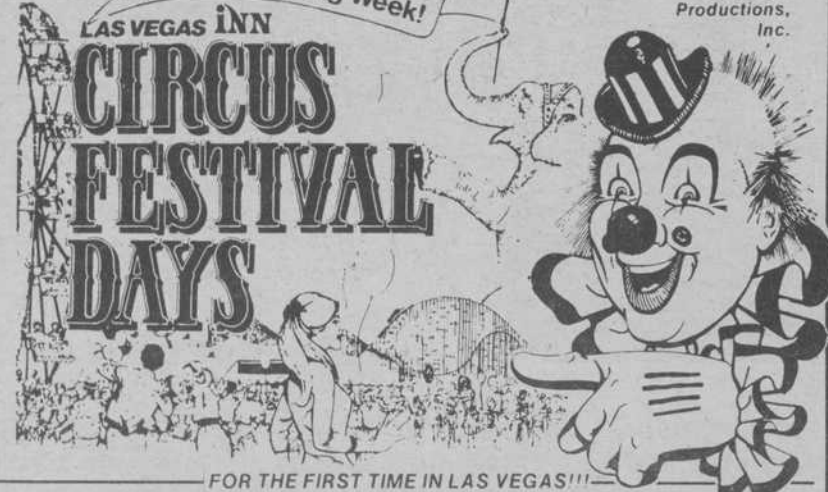
The auction, sponsored by the Cashman Stage Band, is produced yearly to raise funds for the band's travel costs to the Festival Competition.
