

How to Speak Up Assertively is the goal of a 6-week workshop offered by the Re-Entry Center of Clark County Community College.

The two hour workshop on Mondays beginning January 11 and continuing until February 22, is designed to help the individual communicate more effectively in personal, social and work relationships.

Workshop leaders, Dot Bristow and Charlotte Claassen will focus on showing students the distinction between aggressive and assertive behavior. They will demonstrate how to use relaxation techniques; practice new skills through role-playing and how to express positive as well as negative emotions.
