MAN SHOT IN FACE

What police speculate to have been an innocent bystander, a 20-year old man was shot in the head Sunday night when he was standing in front of apartments in West Las Vegas while four men robbed some occupants of a car.

Police identified the victim as Poydras Orlando Page, no address disclosed. He was rushed to Southern Nevada Memorial Hospital, where he was listed in very critical condition, clinging to life.

Page was shot at least once in the head about 7:15 p.m. while he stood in front of 500 W. Jefferson Ave., homicide investigators said.

Police further speculate one of the suspects fired at the robbery victims, with the bullet striking Page. Witnesses were interviewed in an attempt to determine the details of the shooting, including whether the wounded man may have been involved in the robbery or just a bystander.

At Sentinel press time, the suspects remained at large.

WAITING CHILDREN

Kerry is a delightful nine-year-old black boy who has been waiting all his life for a family to adopt him. Kerry needs a family that will nurture and stimulate him, but still be able to accept his limited potential. Kerry is a Downs Syndrome child, and, like all children, he needs the love and security of a family of his own. A black or biracial family is preferred for Kerry, but all families will be considered.

Kerry has attended school since he was 18 months old. He has learned self-help skills and can recognize and print his name, color and count. Kerry speaks in two word sentences and with intense speech therapy his speech has improved. As an adult, he will need sheltered care.

Kerry has an enchanting personality, a good sense of humor and is very polite. While Kerry is a friendly child, he is really not one for kissing. He enjoys being with adults more than with children. Kerry loves music and often dances to rock 'n' roll. When he is not listening to music, he plays with his stuffed toys, looks at pictures in his books, listens to stories or watches television. He especially enjoys Julia Child cooking on her show.

* Kerry is one of many

children with Downs Syndrome who wait for someone to want them. While Downs children are mentally handicapped, many are very high functioning and most are extremely pleasant to be around. These special children need acceptance and love just as all of us do. Can you find room for a child like Kerry in your family?

Red Cross Seeks Volunteers

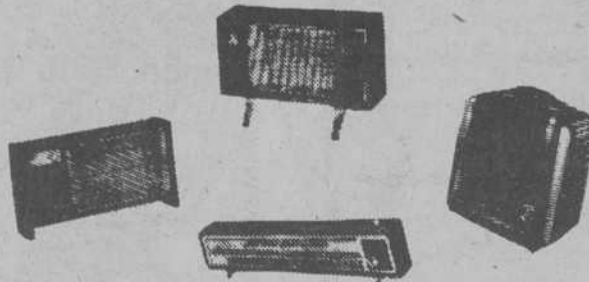
