MAN SHOT IN FACE

What police speculate to have been an innocent bystander, a 20year old man was shot in the head Sunday night when he was standing in front of apartments in West Las Vegas while four men robbed some occupants of a car.

Police identified the victim as Poydras Orlando Page, no address disclosed. He was rushed to Southern Nevada Memorial Hospital, where he was listed in very critical condition, clinging to life.

Page was shot at least once in the head about 7:15 p.m. while he stood in front of 500 W. Jefferson Ave., homicide investigators said.

Police further speculate one of the suspects fired at the robbery victims, with the bullet striking Page. Witnesses were interviewed in an attempt to determine the details of the shooting, including whether the wounded man may have been involved in the robbery or just a bystander.

At Sentinel press time, the suspects remained at large. children with Downs Syndrome who wait for someone to want them. 
