## SHOWBOAT SETS BIG BOXING-WRESTLING CARDS

Thur., Jan. 21, through Thur., Jan. 28— an eight-day period in which the Showboat Hotel, Casino and Bowling Center will present an array of topnotch sporting events including professional boxing, amateur boxing and the biggest name in professional wrestling.

On the 21st it'll be "Andre The Giant," all 7-foot-4-inches, 485 pounds of him, headlining a professional wrestling card.

On Saturday the 23rd it'll be amateur boxing matching the U.S. Navy team against a squad of all-stars from Nevada.

On Tuesday the 26th it'll be Azteca Promotions monthly professional boxing card.

On Wednesday the 27th professional wrestling returns.

All five events will be held in the Showboat Sports Pavilion.

Amateur boxing on the 23rd starts at 7:30 p.m., doors open at 7, and, again, prices are \$10 for ringside reserved and \$5 for general admission.

Azteca's professional boxing card on the 26th starts at 8 p.m., doors open at 7:30, while the ESPN card on the 28th starts earlier at 6 p.m., doors open at 5:30. Prices for both cards are \$15 for ringside reserved and \$10 for general admission.
