The 5th Dimension's popularity has never wavered through the growing and changing times in the entertainment field, and with the dynamic blend of old and new appeal to a wide audience through their upbeat and easy listening sound, they should become a popular addition to the 1100 room Tropicana Hotel.

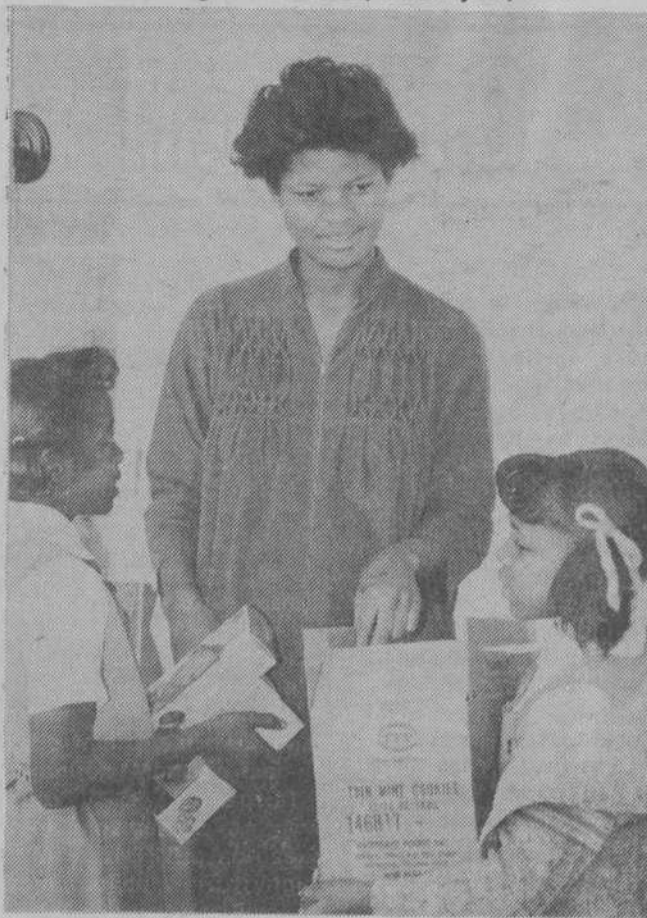

The sale, which is conducted by more than 5,500 girl and adult members, will continue through Feb. 1.

As in past years, Girl Scouts will sell the cookies at major shopping areas and door-to-door in their neighborhoods. Call-in cookie orders will be taken at the Girl Scout Service Center in Las Vegas and delivered by Girl Scouts in matching neighborhoods. Persons wishing to order cookies

Seven varieties of cookies will be available for purchase during the January sale: Mint, Shortbread, Assorted Sandwich Cremes, Peanut Butter Patties, Peanut Butter Sandwich, Old Fashioned Oatmeal, and Caramel deLites. The price, as in 1981, is \$1.50 per box.

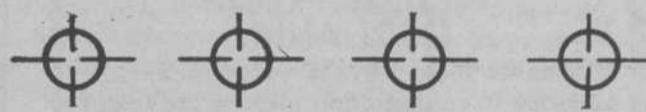
