When a military officer gives the "Forward March!" command, every



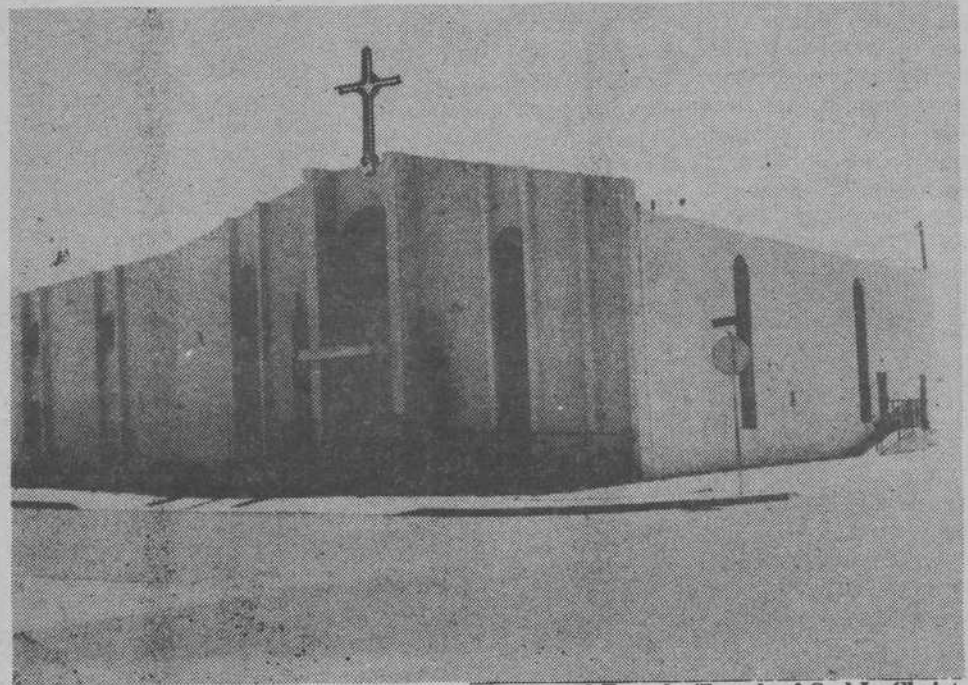
