gress. It could be changed or terminated.

"As we go along, I expect we will encounter some activity from the Klan," Lowery said. "We'll be marching in some new territory when we get into the Carolinas. I don't know what we might face. We won't just go there and turn around and leave. We plan to tarry for awhile and may put up another Resurrection City."

Resurrection City was a makeshift campgrounds erected near the Capitol in 1968 by thousands of marchers led by the late Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

The demonstrators will march through major towns on the route, but drive through rural areas, Lowery said.
