### Year-Round Education Being Studied By School District

A study of year-round education has been undertaken by the Clark County School District as a possible solution to overcrowded facilities.

CCSD executive management assistant Dr. Ron Hawley was assigned to conduct a study which will examine the three existing year-

round elementary schools in the Clark County School District as well as many of the year-round schools nationwide.

According to Hawley, the study will look at voluntary and mandated plans, comparative costs and savings, and

alternative models. Results of the study will be presented to the school board in the near future.

School officials state that classroom space will not be crucial until the 1983-84 school year, when housing problems are expected to become acute for students district-wide.
