

SINATRA TO PRODUCE REBELS BENEFIT CONCERT

LAS VEGAS, NV — It seems like a long time between shows, but the legendary Frank Sinatra has announced that he will put on another "Memorable Evening" on Thursday, June 3, starting at 9 p.m. in the plush Aladdin Theatre for the Performing Arts.

The event will be the 12th Annual UNLV Rebels Club athletic fundraising concert. It was June 10, 1981 when Dr. Sinatra and his galaxy of friends put on the last benefit concert for the University of Nevada, Las Vegas athletic program and the leader of the showroom singers plans on his eighth consecutive UNLV concert being his finest.

University Rebels Club executive director Davey Pearl was elated in making the announcement that Sinatra would again sing for the Rebels. "Every year he helps us. It means more and more to us and to our program here at UNLV. We have a lot of friends in the entertainment world, but none have been stronger in support of our efforts at UNLV than

Frank Sinatra. He has been great to us these past seven years and I honestly can say that I don't know what we would do without him."

Tickets for this "Memorable Evening with Frank Sinatra" are priced at \$100, \$30 and \$20 for the general public and there is a special price of \$15 each for all regular UNLV Athletic scholarship donors. All seats are reserved for this concert and with the \$100 tickets also come a pass to a special post-show "Celebrity Dance" which will also be held at the Aladdin.

All UNLV athletic donors will be feted following the show at their own special "thank you party" which also will be held in the Aladdin.

'WEAVER GIVEN OFFER TO FIGHT DOKES FOR WBA TITLE' — KING

Don King, premier boxing promoter, has offered World Boxing Association heavy-weight champion Mike Weaver a \$750,000 guarantee to fight leading contender Michael Dokes. It would be a mandatory defense of the title.

Weaver is slated to fight in Atlantic City, N.J. against No. 5 ranked Randy Cobb on June 2 in an optional title defense. After that fight he would be required to face the leading available contender.

King made the offer in a telegram issued to Weaver, members of the WBA and to Weaver's attorney, George Glasgow.

In a recent AP release, Weaver was quoted as saying that to be the WBA champion was just a job, and he's not particularly crazy about.

"I'm like the person who goes to work everyday. He might not like it, but he knows he has to do it," said Weaver.

"I hate training, I hate running, I hate getting hit ... I hate all about boxing but the money and the glory of winning."

Weaver, 29, vows to continue training, running and getting hit — and, he hopes, winning — until everyone knows his name as undisputed champion of the world.

His mother wants him to be a minister when he retires from fighting.

Weaver wants to be an actor.

WEAVER TITLE FIGHT POSTPONED

The World Boxing Association heavyweight title fight between champion Mike Weaver and Randall "Tex" Cobb, scheduled for June 2 in Atlantic City, N.J., has been postponed due to a shoulder injury suffered by

Weaver, the SENTINEL learned Monday.

Weaver's attorney George Glasco said "the fight has been postponed due to medical reasons. Mike stretched a muscle in between the left shoulder

and neck area while sparring on Wednesday or Thursday of last week. In two or three weeks he should be fine. They prescribed rest and stretching exercises and some kind of therapy."
