The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) opened the Red Rock Canyon Recreation Lands visitor center to the public last Saturday, according to Kemp Conn, Las Vegas BLM District Manager.

The center will pro-vide informational and interpretative services to the public five days a week, Thursday through Monday, from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Conn says the center contains exhibits dealing with the geological, botanical,

cultural, historical, wildlife and recreational resources in Red Rock Canyon. The center also includes several audiovisual presentations on plant and animal diversity and adaptation.
"The opening of the


