## SNIPES VS WITHERSPOON HEAVYWEIGHT ATTRACTION AT CAESARS SATURDAY

Renaldo "Mister"
Snipes, of Yonkers, N.Y.,
the Yonkers heavyweight who is one of the
few ever to drop champion Larry Holmes, and
"Terrible" Jim Witherspoon, the undefeated
puncher from Philadelphia, will tangle in the
10-round main event at
Caesars Palace, Las
Vegas, on Saturday,
June 5th.

The battle between 7th-ranked Snipes, seeking to stay in the title picture, and 9th-ranked Witherspoon, looking to crash the charmed circle of title contenders, will be televised nationally by ABC's Wide World of Sports and will be promoted here by Don King Productions.

This marks a stellar

week of heavyweight promotion, highlighting a Championship classic between undefeated champion Larry Holmes against undefeated Gerry Cooney, the No. 1 contender, in the specially constructed 32,000 seat outdoor arena at Caesars Palace; and a supporting special 10-rounder pitting No. 3 ranked Greg

Page against No. 4, Trevor Berbick, the Canadian Champion who went the distance with Holmes and defeated and retired Muhammad Ali.

On June 5th the 25-year-old Snipes, an unorthodox boxer-puncher with a devastating right hand, will be fully recovered from a cut arm that hampered

him in his last fight — a draw with Scott Frank in Atlantic City on Mar. 21. The transplanted Texan — he was born in Houston — has beaten "Jumbo" Cummings, Mustapha Muhammad and Gerrie Coetze, and succumbed to Holmes for the title after 11 gruelling rounds. He has won 22 of 24 fights, with 1

knocked out 11 rivals.

Witherspoon, only 24, has stopped 11 of his 24 opponents on an unmarred slate. The muscled Philadelphian has been brought along steadily but slowly and has displayed both power and aggressive boxing skills. His most outstanding victory was a 10-round decision over rugged Marvin Stinson.

## SINATRA UNLV BENEFIT SET FOR THURSDAY


