Kathleen Olson, Ex-ecutive Director of the Governor's Committee on Employment of the Handicapped foresees the contest focusing on abilities of the disabled. Participants are judged on their personal accomplishments, polse, professional goals, adjustment to disability, and social confidence. It is not a beauty contest.

Qualifications to be met include contestants must be 18 years of age and must utilize a wheelchair 50 percent of the time for mobility. They may be either

single, married, divorced or widowed.

In addition to other prizes, the new Miss Wheelchair Nevada will receive an all-expensepaid trip to Columbus, Ohio for herself and companion to vie for the Miss Wheelchair America Crown.

For the past seven years the Sertomans and the Governor's Committee have cosponsored the growing event. Olson said the contest helps promote awareness to the needs of the community in removing architectural and attitudinal barriers which face handicapped persons daily.
