


CONSUMER AFFAIRS PROBLEMS

AND ANSWERS

QUESTION: I live in an appartment with a "month to month" arrangement with the landlord. In other words, we have no long tenure requirement. I may leave at any time, but my rent must be paid each month in advance. When I first moved in, I had to pay a \$100.00 security fee with the understanding, in writing, that it was refundable if, when I move out, the spartment is left in the condition it was in when I first occupied it. I have been offered a good job out of town and I plan to leave immediatley. I went to the landlord to arrange for the return of the 'security" fee. My apartment is spotless with not a single scratch or mark on anything. As a matter of fact, it is in better condition now, than when I first occupied it. The landlord said the security fee is not refundable. I think he is wrong.

ANSWER: According to the Nevada revised statutes, the landlord may claim that portion of the security in such amounts as are reasonably necessary to repair damages to the premises caused by the tenant other than normal wear and pay the reasonable costs of cleaning the premises. If no such work is required, you should receive your security refund. 'If the landlord makes any claims, he must do so no later than 3 weeks after the termination of the tenancy by delivering it to you personally, or mailing it to you at your new address. The landlord, of course, must be able to prove his claim.

The Nevada Consumer Affairs Division is mandated to enforce statewide the laws covered under the Deceptive Trade Practices Act, the Automotive Repair Act and the DoorTo Door Sales Act. The agency is designed to protect and serve the needs of consumers and business persons alike through its offices in Las Vegas and Carson City.
