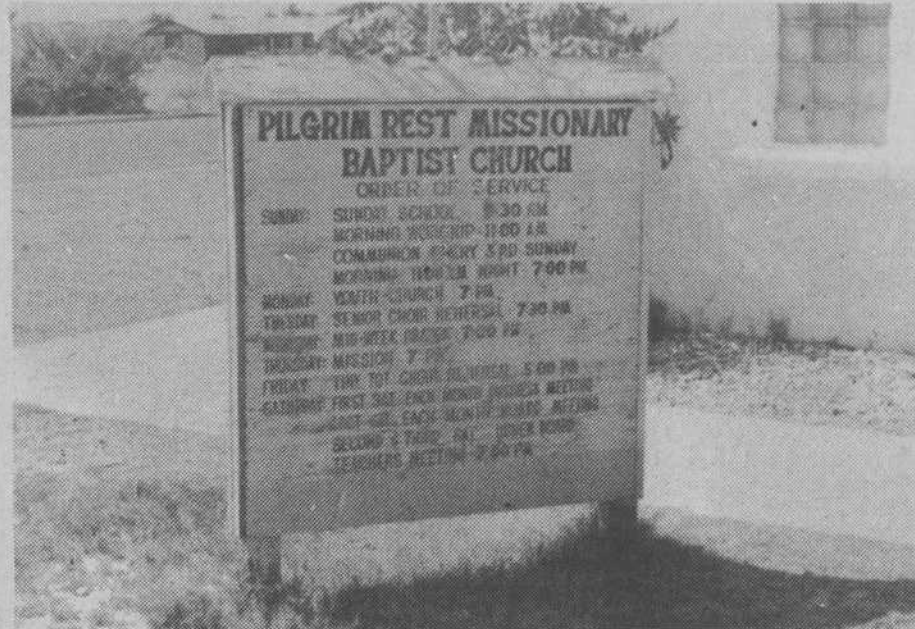

Home Going For Martha Beatrice Polk



November 10, 1911 - June 20, 1982

In the years 1945-52 Elder Alonzo McGhee, Eldest Child of the Polk family, visited and settled in Las Vegas. He was impressed with the city, but was not at ease until his family joined him here.

In 1952 Mrs. Beatrice Polk arrived, coming from Wabback, Arkansas. In 1953 she became a member of Cox's Upper Room Church of God in Christ, was saved and filled with the Baptism of the Holy Ghost, under the leadership of the late Bishop C.C. Cox. This

was the beginning of a great religious victory for the Polk family. With great affection for her family, her desire was to see them all become Christians.

Big Mama Polk was not only concerned about her immediate family. Her work included a prison ministry. Homeless people found refuge under her roof, where the door was always open. No hour was too late for her Counseling service. In addition, she was a faithful member of the Pentecost Temple Church

of God in Christ, where she served faithfully in numerous capacities: a member of the Church Mother's Board; a Sewing Circle member; a Senior Choir member; a Prayer Warrior; a member of the Bible Band; and a faithful Missionary.

She also traveled to Arkansas with her son, Elder Alonzo McGhee, to assist him in the ministry.

She was a renowned individual in the community, and was known as Big Mama.

Mother Polk leaves to mourn her passing 9 children, 4 boys and 5 girls; Cabe Polk of Wabback, Arkansas; Elder Alonzo McGhee; Fred Polk; Willie Polk; Mrs. Martha Miller; Margaret Murray; Cleo Goodwin; Iola Johnson; and Viola Polk of Las Vegas. She also leaves forty-five grandchildren, sixty-five great grandchildren and two great great grandchildren; 1 sister, Mrs. Minnie Rattliff, Chicago, Illinois; 1 sister-in-law, Mrs. Carrie Turner of Pine Bluff, Arkansas; and 1 nephew, Eugene Anderson of Las Vegas.
