
## RUSTIN



USSR frequently is at the forefront of resolutions against imperialism and colonialism, nothing can obscure the fact that the USSR, Itself, is the world's last great remaining colonial empire. The USSR, in fact, is a continuation of the centuries-old Russlan Tsarist Empire and today includes in its clutches such nations as the Ukraine, Lith-uania, Armenia, Geor-gia, Latvia, and Estonia. The peoples of each of these nations, as well as of such Soviet satellites as Poland, Czechoslovakia and Bulgaria, continue to be denied their elementary right to self-determination.

In their overtures to Africa and the Third World, the Soviets have sought to exploit the carefully constructed myth of the USSR as a racially tolerant society. Recent evidence, however, leads to an entirely different conclu-

A study just released by the Rand Corporation, a respected conducts studies for the U.S. government and for private organizations, indicates that racial prejudices are extremely pronounced in the Soviet military and have resulted in violent contion against minorities. The fundamental source of such conflict is between yellow Central Asians, most of whom are Moslems, and white Europeans. Reports of racial incidents involving Soviet citizens and black African students attending Soviet universitles have also reached the West with increasing frequency.

In large measure such prejudice is the product of the offlclal government policy of anti-Semitism, of state opposition to religlous and cultural freeflicts and discrimina- dom, and of the attempt by the Soviet government to Russify the entire population of the USSR, I.e., to impose the Russian language on non-Russian peoples. In part the ethnic and racial prejudice which is viewed in the Rand so widespread in the USSR is the product of an imperial ideology masking itself behind slogans of "friendship among nations" and "internationalism."



As the nations of Africa and of the Third World become more acquainted with the realities of the Soviet system and of the large gap between Soviety rhetoric cessfully fragmented and performance, there will be a further erosion of the USSR's Influence in the Third World.
