

## LAS VEGAS TO RENO OFF-ROAD RACING EXTRAVAGANZA

The Nevada economy will receive a needed \$12 million shot in the arm in October with the inaugural running of the Frontier 500, a Coors Off-Road Series race, the longest and most spectacular off-road race ever held in America.

The economic bonanza will be experienced by all Nevada communities along the Las Vegas-to-Reno race course, according to analysts from Summa Corp., parent company of the race-sponsoring Frontier Hotel in Las Vegas.

The Summa financial experts predict that the more than 500 drivers and their support teams, plus the thousands of off-road fans who will come to watch them, will spend an estimated \$12.6 million during the six-day event, scheduled Oct. 13-18. The analysts called the estimate "conservative."

"It's a rarity when a single event can pick

up the economy of an entire state," Frontier President Phil Arce said, "but the Frontier 500 has this kind of potential. As Nevadans ourselves, we, the sponsors, are particularly pleased that this race will bring new dollars into our smaller cities and rural communities. We're delighted with the enthusiastic manner in which this race has been received throughout the state."

The race, which will begin at dawn on Oct. 16 at Sloan, 15 miles south of Las Vegas, will take the cars past Goodsprings, Pah-rump, Beatty, Goldfield, Tonopah, Gabbs and Virginia City.

Registration will begin on Wednesday, Oct. 13 at the Frontier and technical inspection will be conducted Thursday and Friday at the Strip hotel. Awards ceremonies will be held at the Peppermill in Reno on Sunday and Monday.
