School District Announces Fall Registrations

ROSE WARREN ELEMENTARY

An open fall registration will be held for all students zoned for the Rose Warren Elementary School. Office hours are 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. until August 13. Starting on August 16, regular office hours will be 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily.

All new students must bring records of immunization and birth defects to complete registration.

Returning students may check for their names and class locations which will be posted on the bulletin board outside the school office on August 26 and 27.

Students who attended Warren during the 1981-82 school year under a zone variance must attend the school for which they are zoned as no zone variances will be granted by Rose Warren Elementary at this time.

SUNRISE ACRES ELEMENTARY

Registration is required for all students who will attend Sunrise Acres Elementary School, 2501 Sunrise Avenue, this fall. New and returning students must register prior to Aug. 30, the first regular attendance day. The office will be open for registration Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Kindergarten students are required to have a birth certificate and proof of immunization. Immunization records must also be shown at the time of registration by students previously not enrolled in the Clark County School District. For additional information call the school office at 382-7283.

CHAPARRAL HIGH

Students who are new to the Clark County School District and reside in the Chaparral High School zone may pre-register at Chaparral until Aug. 20. Counselors also will be available from 8-11:30 a.m. and 12-3 p.m. These students must bring proof of residency (utility bill or rent receipt), proof of immunization, and school transcripts.

Returning students and new students zoned to Chaparral must complete final registration in the school gymnasium on Aug. 26 (grades 11 and 12) and Aug. 27 (grades 9 and 10). But transportation will be provided on registration days to North Las Vegas students zoned to Chaparral.

Detailed registration information will be mailed to students beginning Aug. 16. In addition, parents may call 458-8800 for assistance.

Students who are zoned for Rancho but have not pre-registered at the school should pre-register during one of the following days: Aug. 19, 20, 23 or 25. Students pre-registering should report to the assistant principal in charge of zoning with proof of zone residency such as a rent receipt or power bill.

Sunset High School, a comprehensive evening high school, will begin fall registration for returning students on Aug. 26 from 4-6 p.m. New students of high

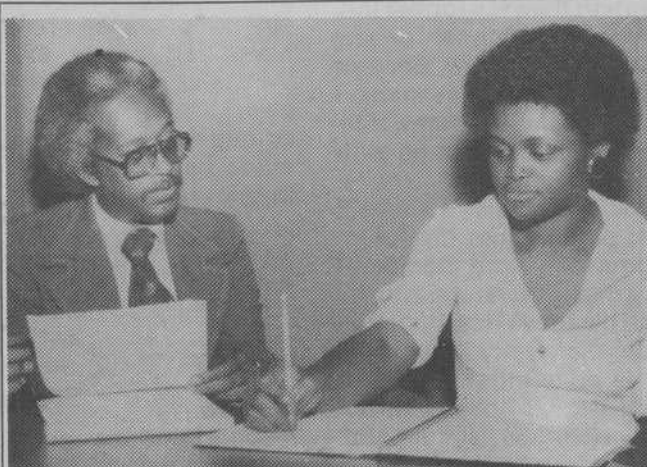
