

## Amateur Boxing Show Set For Aug. 28 At Boat

One of the finer amateur boxing shows of the year comes to the Showboat Hotel, Casino, Country Club and Bowling Center Saturday, Aug. 28, when a team of Nevada all-stars take on their counterparts from Los Angeles County.

At least 20 bouts in both the open and novice divisions will be contested beginning at 7 p.m. in the Showboat Sports Pavilion. Doors open at 6:30.

Tickets, priced at \$10 for ringside reserved and \$5 for general admission, are on sale daily at the Showboat Sports Pavilion Ticket Office.

Eight Las Vegas are on the Nevada open squad: Avery Caldwell at 112 pounds, Alex Gonzales at 125, Robert Cantu at 132, Ronnie

Washington and Joe Salomone at 156, Travis Martin and Larry Welch at 165 and Ken Adams at heavyweight.

Other team members, all from Reno, include Jimmy Zumba at 106, Bobby Simibaldi at 119, Guy Leyva and Don French at 125, Bobby Adamson at 132, John Sheppard at 139, Ron Sobola at 147 and Mike Martino at 178.

Eight of these boxers won championships earlier this month at a tournament pitting Nevada against the best from California, Oregon and Washington: Zumba, Caldwell, Simibaldi, Adamson, Sheppard, Sobola, Martin and Martino.

Las Vegas novices who'll be in action at the Showboat include James Reagan at 119, Michael Nelson at 132, Michael Nevius at 139,

Leonard Munoz at 147, Lorin Perrott at 156, Reggie Young at 165, Robert Dugan at 178 and James Greer at heavyweight. Reagan, Munoz and Dugan also won championships at the four-state tournament.

This is the first time that Nevada has competed against Los Angeles in this annual invitational series. Last year Nevada boxed a U.S. Navy team.

"This series is excellent preparation for big tournaments later this year and early next year," says Lt. Hal Miller, president of Golden Gloves of Nevada, Inc., and tournament director. "It gives us a good indication of how we're progressing on a national level."

The Regional USA-ABF tournament, involving Nevada, California, Arizona and Utah, is in November and the National USA-ABF Championships is in December in Indianapolis. In March is the Regional Golden Gloves tournament, involving Nevada, California, Arizona, Oregon and Washington, followed by the Nationals in Albuquerque.

The Nevada team is coached by Doc Broadus and trained by Glen Powell. Stony Dunn is the supervisor.
