
TABAT NOMINATED FOR NATIONAL CONSTABLE OF THE YEAR

LV Woman Raped, Kidnapped, Robbed By Three Gunmen In West Las Vegas


Three men kidnapped, raped and robbed

The assailants dropped her off two blocks from the club after taking some money and jewelry from her.


