ANDRETTI WILL RACE IN CAESARS GRAND PRIX

LAS VEGAS — Excellent; that's how Mario Andretti rates his chances at Saturday's Caesars Palace Grand Prix, the final race on this year's Grand Prix schedule.

Andretti, the 1978 World Driving Champion, announced that he will be driving one of two Ferraris in the Las Vegas event Sept. 2. His participation had been a question mark because of a commitment to run the Detroit News Grand Prix 150, a CART Indy Car event Sept. 26.

But Andretti's CART car owner, U.E. "Pat" Patrick, consented to Andretti running the Ferrari in Las Vegas, and then starting at the back of the field in a non-qualified car in Michigan under the promoter's option.

How does Andretti feel about starting in a car that has not been qualified? "I'd rather not," he said, "but it seems silly to go ahead and run the car in qualifications when I'd have to start at the back of the field anyway."

Still, Andretti is looking forward to racing at Caesars Palace. "I'd say my chances are excellent," he says.
