CLARK COUNTY COMMUNITY COL-LEGE is going into its eleventh year and 10,075 students are being served in a variety of academic opportunities. This figure represents a 22.1% increase over the 1981-82 academic year

demic year.

The College began registration for the spring semester November 15, 1982, and continues through January 21, 1983. In order to meet the needs of the public, the College has a new procedure for registration — by phone—call 643-0830, 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. and 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. Mondays through Thursdays and 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Fridays unto 3 p.m. on Fridays un

til December 23, 1982. Students will select courses from the spring course schedule which is available at the College and throughout the city at libraries, banks, supermarkets, and 7-11 stores.

Call the College between specified hours at 643-6060 and set up an appointment for faculty advising or counseling. This will eliminate waiting in those long lines to find out the course has been filled.

This new registration procedure has been implemented in order to expand the counseling program at Clark County Community College.

This system will allow each student to receive more individual guidance in the selection of the course or program of study chosen by the student.

This is certainly a step in the right direction.
