AMERICAN FILM FESTIVAL **RED RIBBON AWARD WINNERS** TO BE SHOWN

The envelope, please! And, the winners of the 1982 American Film Festival Awards are . . . free for public viewing at the Flamingo Library. A selected screening of these outstanding 16mm films, produced by the best of American filmmakers, will be presented in the auditorium at 7 p.m. on November

15, 17, 18 and on November 19 and 20 at 3 p.m.
"A Cowhand's Song: Crises on the Range," among the selections being shown, was filmed in Nevada and funded by the Nevada Humanities Committee. It depicts the lifestyle of cattle ranchers who run their cattle on public lands. The 28 minute film documents a 20th Century range war where words are the weapons and the battlefields are the courts and conference rooms.

Other films included in the series are "A Helping Hand" which chronicles the marvel of freeing child-ren from the handicap of a missing limb. "Living Treasures of Japan" focuses on nine artisans and performing artists who keep an ancient culture alive in a contemporary society. "No Other Love" spotlights the problems of a slightly retarded couple who wish to marry and must convince everyone that their love is valid and that they should be married. "Xian" presents a cultural history of the ancient Chinese imperial city and includes extensive footage of one of the world's most spectacular archaeological sites, the tomb of Qin Shi Huant Di, China's first emperor and builder of the Great Wall.

Nearly thirty films in all will be shown free to the public. A complete list will be posted outside the auditorium at the library.
