## HELP FOR THE HANDICAPPED

The Center for Independent Living, located at 2401 West Bonanza Road, and the Westside Community Development Commission located at 330 West Washington Avenue have applied for a joint venture grant to be used to make the homes of the handicapped living in the Old West Side and Vegas Heights more accessible and comfortable, as well as convenient.

If granted, the funds will be used to build sidewalks and door entrance ramps, install grab bars in bathrooms,

widen doors for wheelchairs, build foot stools, etc., at no cost to the individuals. Also, if we are successful in getting the money, our program will run from July, 1983 through June 30, 1984.

We are now making a survey in order to locate those handicapped people in West Las Vegas. We are asking all handicapped people in our community in please call my office at 647-2177, and leave your name, and address and phone number, and every attempt will be made to provide you with some type of ser-

vice during our program period. If you are not handicapped, but you know a person, or persons who is handicapped, please call our office and register this person for them.

Our program will provide services for those in wheelchairs, on canes, crutches, walkers, bed-ridden, etc.

If our grant application is approved, our program will be the only one of its kind in the Las Vegas Valley.

Call our office immediately, and register for our "FREE" Handicapped Program Service. CALL us regardless of your handicap.
