## S ROLE OF

The much coveted role of the late Egyptian President Anwar Sadat in a forthcoming TV movie being prepared for the Operation Prime Time network, has been offered to Oscar Winner Lou Gossett, Jr. It is expected that he will accept the role.

The much soughtafter part was vied for by such other movie greats as Dustin Hoffman. However, it was felt by the producers that the sale of the movie overseas might be hampered if a Jewish actor, such as Hoffman and several others who were suggested, was chosen.

Other considerations taken in choosing the actor to play the Sadat role included the goodwill and approval of Jihan Sadat, the widow of the famed leader, and whether or not some Americans would accept a black actor in the role, even though Sadat, who was half-Sudanese (his mother was Black), was considered by many to be a Black man and looked Black.

In the final analysis,

the producers decided to do the logical thing they chose an actor who is regarded as being brilliant in his field. That actor was Lou Gossett,

Getting this coveted role comes right on the

heels of his having series with Gossett received the Academy Award for his outstanding supporting role as the Sargeant in "An Officer and a Gentleman." It is highly speculated now that the movie might be made into a TV

headlining.

Gossett also handled the network color commentary for the Holmes-Witherspoon fight held at the Dunes last Friday night.
