
JACKSON STREET & ME . . .

C.E.T.A. TRAINEES LEARN CONSTRUCTION

Ten C.E.T.A. Program enrollees began an intensive apprenticeship training program with the West Side Community Development Commission on Monday, June 13. The ten week training program will run through August 20.

While in training, the youth will be exposed to such building trades crafts such as carpentry, cement work, dry wall construction, electrical work, floor covering, glazing, house painting, perfataping, plastering, sheet metal work, construction materials, and construction safety.

They will be paid \$3.35 per hour by the U.S. Department of Labor.

Their on-the-job training will consist of refurbishing the homes of low income senior citizens in the Old West Side and Vegas Heights.

Trainees assigned to the West Side Community Development Commission include Roy Caroll, Stephen "Paris" McCall, Stephanie Cherry, John Chipman, Lawrence Davis, Donald Hender-Marvel Kline, Raymond McDonald. Ramona Rhone, Danny Williams, and Patricio Williams. They are being trained by H.P. Fitzgerald, Executive Director, and Senior Training Officer, and James Cunegin, Field Coordinator, and Construction Superintendent.

The program includes group games, small table games, arts and crafts projects and some field trips.


