

The weakness in the system is that we still have white jurors who cannot render a fair and impartial verdict where blacks are charged with a sex crime against white women. One, if black, must ask the question, "what would the verdict have been if the charge had been against a prominent white lawyer and the girls in the case had been black?" I would venture to say that there would have been a not guilty verdict.


The white woman's protection in this state should not be any greater than that for the black sister. If th white woman plays, she should be subject to all the emotional pains of unrequited love just as anyone else and not be allowed to use the criminal justice system as a means of seeking revenge because she could not have a brother when she wanted him.
