Robber wounds arcade clerk

A clerk in Happy Dave's Casino, storefront slot arcade at 1201 Las Vegas Blvd. South, was shot Sunday by a robber who forced her to open the safe and a money drawer, and escaped with an undetermined sum, Metro Police said.

Marlene Savis suffered a 22 caliber bullet wound in the hip and was hospitalized in the 8 p.m. incident. She was also punched in the mouth by the gunman, police said.

The slot arcade apparently had no customers when the bandit walked in, they said. He punched the woman in the face when she first refused to open the safe on his orders, then fired two warning shots near her, they said.
