some of the reasons Blacks do not plan on Las Vegas, but subtle racism and snobbery from local Blacks rank high in persuading Blacks to choose Atlanta, Los Angeles, the Bahamas, etc. Affluent Blacks look for warm reception, genuine hospitality and good service. The Southern hospitality, warmth and friendliness shown elsewhere show the lack of same in Las Vegas.

This writer is not aware of any real determined effort to bring Blacks to Las Vegas. In the East, Eastern Airlines has a vice-president devoted to encouraging Blacks to go to Atlanta and the Bahamas and other Carribbean areas by running special airfares along with special lodging in participating hotels and even ball games, other group and convention affairs. Atlanta's Convention Bureau goes all out to secure conventions, reunions, etc. The Blacks in the Las Vegas Convention Bureau are apparently not being used to secure Black business. When I talked with Mr. Ralenkotter some time back, he said he was in good rapport with Blacks and that it was not neccessary to send Blacks as emmisaries for the Black dollars. While I was chairman of the local S.C.L.C. (Southern Christian Leadership Conference), I asked at the convention that they would hold their next convention in Las Vegas. They decided to hold it here, but dissension in the local branch stopped them from


This program is targeted at parents and concerned citizens to help them to identify drug use, and the possible effects on the abuser. The program will last 1 1/2 hours and is free of charge.
