Caesars Captures Holmes-Frazier WBC Heavyweight Fight

Caesars Palace captured a boxing coup Tuesday by signing the much-touted Larry Holmes World Boxing Council heavyweight title defense against unbeaten Marvis Frazier, son of former heavyweight champion Joe Frazier, at Caesars Palace on Nov. 25.

Larry Holmes will defend his World Boxing Council heavyweight title against unbeaten Marvis Frazier Nov. 25 at Caesars Palace hotel officials announced Tuesday.

The fight, which will be shown in prime time by NBC Sports, will be held in the hotel's 15,000-seat outdoor stadium.

"We are very happy to welcome heavyweight champion Larry Holmes back to Caesars Palace," said the resort's President and Chief Operating Officer Harry Wald. "We, of course, are looking forward to hosting such a tremendous young talent as Marvis Frazier as well."

While neither was willing to disclose the purses for the fighter, Muhammed said Holmes would receive "well over \$2 million while Frazier will receive in the neighborhood of \$800,000 to \$1 million."

Holmes, admittedly in the twilight of his career, will bring a 44-0 mark into the bout against Frazier, the son of former heavyweight champion, Joe Frazier. Frazier is 10-0 with six knockouts.

Holmes is coming off a title defense against Scott Frank in which Holmes retained his crown with a knockout in a mismatch.

Holmes defended his title in Las Vegas earlier this year when he scored a split decision over Tim

Witherspoon at the Dunes Hotel.

Ticket prices range from \$25 to \$300 for ring-



side seats.

The fight will be promoted by Robert Andreoli and Murad Muhammed.
