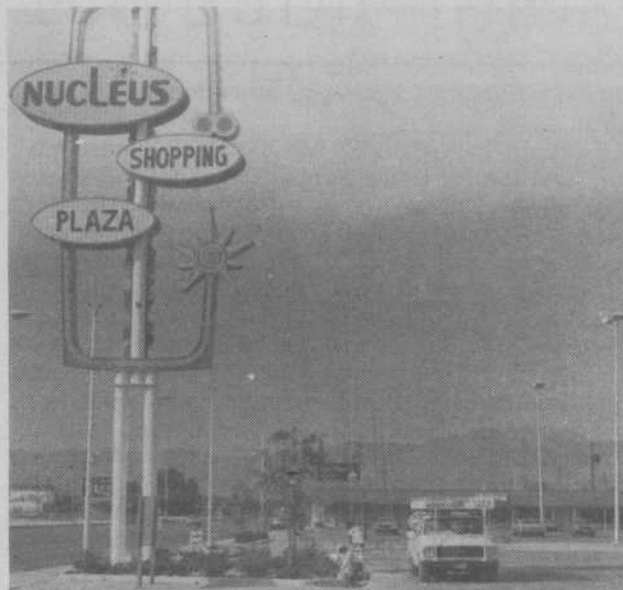


COMMUNITY PROGRESS

This is another view of the Nucleus Shopping Center presently undergoing a complete facelift job to include landscaping throughout the area.



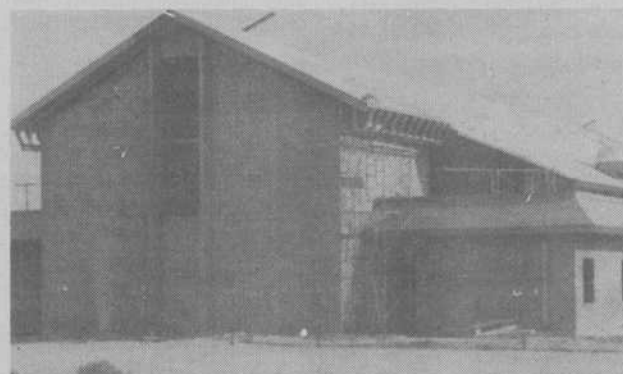

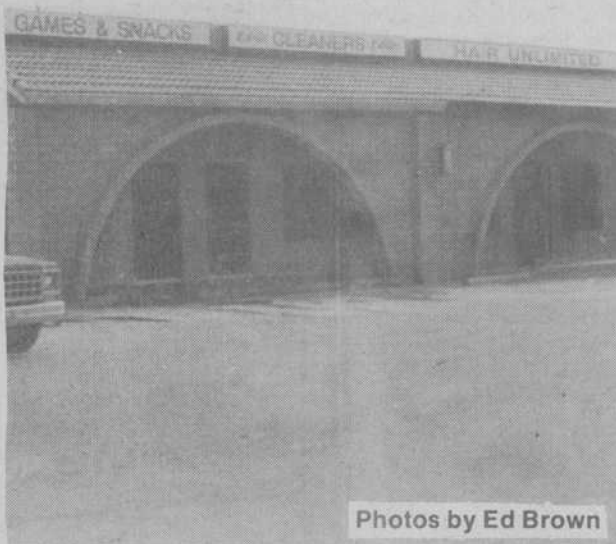

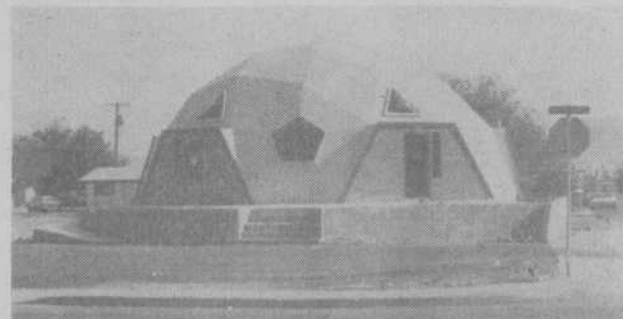
