

Man Gets Jail For Attacking Three With Fork

District Judge Donald Mosley Monday sena man who dresses as a women to 12 years in prison for attacking a family with a long carving fork in May. Herbert Moore, 27, was sentenced to six years each on two counts of false imprisonment with the use of a deadly weapon. The sentences are to run conse-

Mosley gave Moore credit for 135 days he has served in the Clark County Jail.

Moore pleaded guilty to the charges in October after Mosley declared a mistrial in his trial on two counts of second degree kidnapping and attempted grand larceny in the incident.

That trial ended in a hung jury at 11-1 in favor of conviction.

Unidentified Man Shot In Back Of Head

Police are attempting to identify a man who is in critical condition after being shot in the back of his head Tuesday morn-

Sgt. Gary Rainey said a resident in the 100 block of East Owens Ave. told North Las Vegas Police that she saw a man stumbling and fall-

ing to the street across from her apartment at about 6:45 a.m.

She told police the man appeared to be drunk the way he was teetering back and forth.

But when police arrived at the scene, they found a black male with "a scraggly beard," in his late 20s or early 30s, with a gunshot wound to the back of his head.
