a few shows which have received this org.'s stamp of approval. They are: "Wednesday," about an Afro-American family-owned newspaper that was shot on the office location of the Los Angeles Sentinel. Filmed in April the pilot of this drama/comedy series received high praise, but co-producers Stan Taylor and LeRoy McDonald have yet to find a show place for same. Theodore Wilson, Marguerite Ray and Roxanne Reese are among the cast. Also "Fade Out: The Erosion of Black Images." Robert Hooks is the host of this one which will be part of the PBS series, "Matters of Life and Death." Cab Calloway, Avon Long, blues singer Willie Smith and artist Romare Bearden will be seen in segments. The 1 1/2 hr. videotape of Bill Cosby, correctly titled, "Himself," and available for home consumption, also got the good nod from the BAD-C. It was written and directed by the comic with backing frills from award winning Afro-American cinematographer Joe (Roots) Wilcots.
