

#### 4 Two Brothers Slain At Safari Room During Argument Buried Monday

Two young slain brothers, Ricky and Terry Collins, found shot to death on Jan. 8 at the Safari Room, 810 W. Bonanza Road allegedly following an argument, were buried Monday at Woodlawn Cemetery.

The Rev. Sam Carroll eulogized them as "quiet boys, who kind of lived in the streets."

Ricky, 25, an unemployed janitor, and Terry, 23, an unemployed casino porter, were born in Banks, Ark. They had both lived 20 years in Las Vegas.

Hundreds of relatives, friends and acquaintances mourned them at the True Love Missionary Baptist Church before their burial Monday at Woodlawn Cemetery. The church was filled with mourners.

One of the brothers' bereaved relatives followed the caskets in which their bodies were carried into the church crying, "Two of them, two of them."

As of Monday no arrests had been made in the slayings. Five persons sat drinking at the bar at the time of the shootings, but they told police nothing that could shed light on the killings.

They are survived by their parents, Richard and Gladys Collins, of Las Vegas, two brothers, Tommy and Marvin Collins, of Las Vegas; five sisters, Willie Tatum, Bobbie Childs, Alice Collins, all of Banks, and Tommie Picket and Rosie Collins, of Las Vegas, and many aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, cousins and friends. Terry also is survived by his girlfriend, Sharon Ricks, of Las Vegas.

This is not REECo's method of recruitment and no one should pay so-called dues to anyone representing themselves as a REECo recruiter.
