Heisman Winner Rozier To Report to Pittsburgh

PITTSBURGH-Heisman Trophy winner Mike Rozier has no intention of challenging a multimillion dollar contract with the Pittsburgh Maulers of the United States Football League and plans to report to training camp this weekend, his new agent said Monday.

Attorney Art Wilkin-son of Philadelphia also said he did not mean to imply in a Boston Globe interview that Rozier had felt pressured by his first agent, Mike Trope, into signing with the expansion team.

The story quoting Wil-kinson had reported that Trope threatened to reveal that the Nebraska All American running back had accepted money from him before the player's senior year in college.

Any inference in the story that that happened isn't true," Wilkinson said.

"I was misquoted or quoted out of context." he said.

"I have to believe that no threats were made.

Wilkinson also said that Rozier did not sign a contrat with Trope until several hours after Nebraska lost 31-30 to Miami in the Orange Bowl Jan.

Wilkinson, who said Rozier fired Trope last

Friday, said the top pick in the USFL draft had signed a contract with Trope at 3 a.m., Jan. 3 and signed an agreement, reportedly worth \$3.1 million over three years, with the Maulers at 4 a.m.

He said Rozier, who was traveling from Japan to the United States, has no intention of trying to challenge the Maulers' agreement in court.




