How Certain Drugs Can Be Used to Aid Competitors

Drug	Sports	Description
Anadrol-50	Weight events Weight lifting	A potent anabolic and androgenic drug. Although it is widely prescribed to be "stacked," or taken in conjunction, with HGH, the Human Growth Hormone. Anadrol-50 is known to have many negative side effects.
Anavar	Sprinting Wrestling Boxing Swimming	At least five milligrams of this anabolic steroid every day with other anabolic steroids. It will build strength without too much muscular enlargement. More effective if taken with a combination of two types of amino acids and a dash of protein powder. Anavar is a good choice for women because it's androgenic—masculinizing—qualities are low.
Clomid	Bodybuilding Weight lifting Weight events	This fertility drug for women is taken near the end of a cycle of testosterone users. Men use it because when they take heavy dosages of testosterone, their body quits producing it naturally. One side effect is that their testicles shrink. Clomid regenerates the body's natural testosterone production, helping testicles to return to normal size.
Deca-durabolin	Weight events Sprinting	A powerful synthetic testosterone derivative. It is an injectable drug. Can become bloated with fluid retention. Usually taken with oral steroids, and amino acids.
Dianabol	Middle distances Long jumping High jumping Football Weight lifting Weight events	This is the first synthetic anabolic steroid, but is no longer available by prescription in U.S. Eating habits must be curbed when using drug without great weight gains. Dianabol is considered a strong steroid, and helps in aggressiveness.
HCG	Bodybuilding	Human Chorionic Gonadotropin comes from the urine of pregnant women, and is primarily used in weight-control clinics to help obese patients lose weight. Bodybuilders call HCG a "cutting" drug, which means they use it to reduce fat. It may have some anabolic effect.
Nolvadex	Weight lifting Bodybuilding	It is an anti-estrogen drug, prescribed to women with breast cancer. It is used by athletes to restart testosterone production at the end of a heavy steroid cycle.
Methandriol	Sprinting Boxing Wrestling Swimming	This anabolic steroid has much of the same results as Anavar. It also works best with a combination of two types of amino acids and protein powder. It will help an athlete gain strength, without great weight gains. It is usually "stacked" with testosterone.
Primabolin	Boxing Wrestling Running	A steroid believed to be effective in weight loss. It may be the only anabolic steroid that will increase muscle size and still—along with a low-calorie diet—reduce fat. Primabolin is not commercially available in the U.S. because the Food and Drug Administration has not approved it. Many European athletes, however, sell it on the black market in the U.S.
Testosterone	Weight events Football Weight events Weight lifting Bodybuilding	A potent injectable that results in aggressive behavior by users. Some athletes say it doesn't stop working on the field of play, causing complications with family, friends and sometimes the law. Men often take Clomid at the end of their testosterone cycle.
Winstrol	Weight events Running Swimming Tennis	This anabolic steroid is considered to be less potent than Dianabol, and often used by women athletes. Most women need strength, have little use for added size, and no use for masculinizing effects such as low voice and facial hair growth.
