NLV Marshal Fired In Alleged Bribery Attempt

NO. LAS VEGAS — A Municipal Court marshal has been fired after he refused to submit to a polygraph test to clear his name in an alleged bribery attempt, it was reported in the Las Vegas Sun last Thursday.

Sources said the marshal, Maurice Hines, declined to take the test after being accused of accepting a bribe to pull a shoplifting ticket from the records.

And a woman who allegedly passed the bribe to Hines, Dorothy Burgess, reportedly was fired at twice from a passing car two days after the alleged bribery came to light.

Hines is alleged to have accepted \$300 to quash the petty larceny citation by eliminating it from the court's computer system after the money was passed to him by Burgess. A subsequent quarrel between the pair resulted in her admitting the bribe details to law enforcement officials. Hines was later

confronted with the charges.

Burgess has reportedly taken a polygraph and was found "not deceptive in her answers."


