

McColl Wins Re-election

Jeff McColl scored a lopsided victory Tuesday to gain a second three-year term in office as secretary-treasurer of Culinary Local 226 as the four-union strike ended its 44th day after a federal mediator recessed negotiations.

McColl got 72.9 percent of the vote, 5,073 compared to former secretary-treasurer Ben Schmoutey, who had 678.

Mary Powers 472, Carlos Ramirez 468 and Lupe Nieves 177.

Incumbent vice president Rudi Bath had 57.7 percent of the votes, with 3,350. He outdistanced Julius George with 670, Naomi Marquez with 591, Dick Porcaro with 988 and Ed Tesko with 203.

Ballots were cast from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. in the Gold Room of the Las Vegas Convention Center, with members standing in line outside the center allowed in at 7 p.m. when the doors were locked. The last member voted at 8:05 p.m.

A total of 7,360 votes were cast, with members using 100 voting booths divided into eight alphabetical precincts. Ballot Security Systems Inc. oversaw the voting and counting.

The vote was more than the 6,800 cast in the last Culinary election in 1981.
