

LV Outlines Recreation Summer Programs

Richard Campbell, Director of the City of Las Vegas' Department of Recreation and Leisure Activities, applauded the City Council's recent action in approving a modified summer youth program for the City of Las Vegas.

A recent survey conducted by the Department of Recreation and Leisure Activities among former paying participants showed that those using these programs were willing to pay moderate fee increases to make them more self supporting.

The City staff, in conjunction with the Citizens Priority Advisory Committee, reviewed other funding sources available for paying the remaining costs of the reduced summer program. The remaining operational costs not covered by the moderate fee increases were identified from savings to the City from the recent private contracting of the City's summer adult softball program.

The pool user fee will be increased from 25 cents to 35 cents daily for ages 17 and under; from 75 cents to \$1 daily for 18 and older; from \$15 to \$25 for unlimited family season pass; and from \$6 to \$10 for ten one-hour swimming lessons.

Structured indoor playground program fees will be collected for the first time this summer, at a rate of \$4 per week, \$12 per month, \$20 per season and \$25 for the family season. Day camp charges go from \$15 to \$25.

Pools will be open Memorial Day, May 28, until Labor Day, Sept. 3. The public can swim from 1 to 6 p.m. Monday thru Saturday, while the Learn to Swim programs will be held in the morning, all under the supervision of Water Safety Instructor-certified personnel.

The structured indoor playground programs at 18 elementary school sites will operate from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday thru Thursday for children from 6 to 12 years old. The program, which runs from June 11 to Aug. 9, includes activity trips, arts and crafts, dance and drama.
