### **PSC Conducted HearingsOn Westside Bus**

The Public Service Commission had open hearings Friday that Chairman Scott Craigie hopes will finally resolve the status of the Westside Charter Bus Service.

"We need to sift through the court decision and various orders made by the previous commission," Craigie said.

The Friday hearing in Las Vegas concerned procedural matters, Craigie said. Later this summer, he expects the commission will hold several days of hearings on a request by Westside to expand its service. Several competing bus companies already have registered protests. Westside is requesting commissioners give the authority to run more than 10 buses and to operate in the more lucrative sightseeing areas.

Westside now mainly runs buses to the Nevada Test Site, the state prison at Jean and a limited sightseeing tour in parts of Las Vegas.


