

## Centel Business Customers To Find New Monthly Charges

Centel business customers will find a new charge ordered by the Federal Communications Commission on their monthly telephone bills starting Friday.

A \$6 access charge to help replace the subsidy of local service by long distance call revenues lost when AT&T was broken up earlier this year will be added to June telephone bills for each telephone line.

The term "access charge" refers to a fee for giving a customer the ability to dial into long distance lines.

The access charge

applies to all business and customers with more than two telephone lines or with single lines in separate locations.

Originally, both residential and business customers were scheduled to begin paying access charges when AT&T was dissolved into smaller companies Jan. 1.

The residential access charges have been delayed several times and are currently slated to begin appearing on bills June 1, 1985. Business telephone access charges could be increased on that date.

## Candidates Reminded Of Filing Deadline July 3

Candidates are reminded that Tuesday, July 3, is the last day in which to file for the public offices of their choices.

July 3 also is the last day that a registered voter can affiliate with a political party or change party affiliation and vote in the primary election under the new party registration.

Friday, June 8, is the last day a candidate seeking public office

through petition may file such petitions with the Registrar of Voter's Office. Candidates filing for an office by petition will appear only on the general election ballot, and will be listed as independent candidates.

## PSC Conducted Hearings On Westside Bus

The Public Service Commission had open hearings Friday that Chairman Scott Craigie hopes will finally resolve the status of the Westside Charter Bus Service.

"We need to sift through the court decision and various orders made by the previous commission," Craigie said.

The Friday hearing in Las Vegas concerned procedural matters, Craigie said. Later this summer, he expects the commission will hold several days of hearings on a request by Westside to expand its service. Several competing bus companies already have

registered protests.

Westside is requesting commissioners give the authority to run more than 10 buses and to operate in the more lucrative sightseeing areas.

Westside now mainly runs buses to the Nevada Test Site, the state prison at Jean and a limited sightseeing tour in parts of Las Vegas.
