

# Black Muslim minister sees awesome race wars in 2 years

According to the United Press International release on Sunday, Black Muslim minister Louis Farrakhan, a prominent supporter of Jesse Jackson's presidential campaign, predicts blacks will "settle the score" with whites in cataclysmic race wars within two years.

In a tape obtained by the Chicago Tribune, the religious leader warned his followers: "I don't have evil in my heart, but I do know if I'm allowed to continue to do what God . . . has put in my heart, we'll have the most awesome war machine that the Earth has ever seen."

"We're going to shake the world."

Farrakhan told the all-black audience at his South Side mosque in the speech made on Mar. 11, "We were born to settle the score. Some of the whites are going to live; maybe a few, quite a few."

"But (God) doesn't want them living with us. He has called us out for His glory, and He doesn't want us mixing ourselves up with the slave-masters' children whose time of doom has arrived."

In Sunday's editions, the Tribune reported previously undisclosed portions of a speech Farrakhan made on Mar. 11. During a broadcast portion of that speech, Farrakhan called Adolf

Hitler a "very great man" and made an implied threat to a black Washington Post reporter who disclosed that Jackson referred to Jews as "Hymies."

After the broadcast ended, Farrakhan went on to describe street gang members as "born warriors for true liberation (who are) awaiting the voice of the Messiah."

"I speak, and they're hearing His voice, and so they don't have no desire to fight the voice that they were born to listen to. And now word comes to us out of the jails, word comes to us from the streets: 'We're with you, brother.'"

Farrakhan said urban street gangs "are going to play a very important part in supporting and defending the black community." He told the group he expects the race wars to break out by 1986, the Tribune said.

Farrakhan's remarks about Hitler and his alleged threats against the black reporter led many Democrats to urge Jackson to repudiate Farrakhan's support.

But Jackson has refused to cut off his relationship with Farrakhan, leader of the Chicago-based Nation of Islam, a black separatist group sprung from the Black Muslims.

Farrakhan, who has publicly soft-pedaled much of his anti-white sentiment during the Jackson campaign, split from the Chicago-based American Muslim Mission when the larger group decided to allow whites to join.

## HUD Chief Sets Seminar

Fay G. Adams, manager of the Las Vegas office of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), has announced plans to hold a seminar in mid-July.

The seminar will explain details of many of the changes in HUD programs. The changes are an attempt to lower housing costs, reduce red tape, eliminate duplicating and inspections of local departments and place a greater reliance on local government.

HUD Secretary Samuel R. Pierce, Jr., initiator of the program changes, is expected to give the keynote address.

Several governmental leaders and representatives from Southern Nevada mortgage banks, home builders, and the real estate industry have been invited to speak.

The location of the meeting has yet to be announced.

## Petitions For Nolen Recall Distributed

Petitions for the recall of Las Vegas City Councilman Bob Nolen were distributed last Thursday night, after attorneys for disgruntled Ward 3 residents gave the drafts their approval.

"There's no doubt in our minds we'll get this thing signed, and signed quick," Carlene Perkins, president of the Sarah Allen Community Development Credit Union and leader of the recall drive, said. "We don't plan on having anything less than 2,000 signatures."

The group of residents, centered in the city's West Side, need signatures of 1,019 registered voters from Ward 3 by July 15 in order to put the recall election gears in motion.

Residents filed for the recall May 14, and again May 16 when it was learned one of the persons who filed for the petition was not a registered voter.

Originally complaining of Nolen's lack of support for the Sarah Allen Credit Union receiving Community Development Block Grant funds, the group says its complaints focus on Nolen's treatment of them whenever they try to talk to him about the West Side community.

"It must be stressed that many concerned, in-

terested citizens have called to inform me they want to become part of the recall, because of Mr. Nolen's belligerent demeanor," Perkins said. "We want to make an example of Mr. Nolen."

## Jackson campaign offices burglarized

LOS ANGELES—The Rev. Jesse Jackson's local campaign headquarters were discovered ransacked and burglarized early Friday, with the front window shattered by a rock, police say.

Thieves took a microwave oven and typewriter from Jackson's Wilshire Blvd. headquarters, police Lt. Dan Hills said. A small amount of cash also may have been stolen, he said.

Jackson was campaigning Thursday in New Jersey in his quest for the Democratic presidential nomination.

## Prison Inmate Shot In Escape Try

CARSON CITY — A Nevada prison inmate was shot in the lower back by a guard Sunday during an escape attempt.

Freddy Mark was released from Carson-Tahoe Hospital after treatment for the wound.

## SARAH ALLEN CREDIT UNION CLARIFIES RECALL PETITION

Tommy L. Frazier, Manager of Sarah Allen Community Development Credit Union, in a statement released to the press Monday, stated that the Sarah Allen Community Development Credit Union had no association with the filing of the recall petition to unseat City Councilman Bob Nolen.

The initiation of this petition was enacted by other members and organizations in the local community.

Carlene Perkins, President of The Credit Union, stated that her position on Bob Nolen's recall was not the consensus of the Credit Union, but was rather her personal expression of displeasure with the report that Bob Nolen has

with his constituents in the Ward 3.

Frazier said that although S.A.C.D.C.U. did not receive funds from the City of Las Vegas, it intends to continue in contributing to the development of West Las Vegas.

Sarah Allen's credentials, licenses, and other operating credentials remain in good standing with Federal, State, and Local authorities.

Its new location at 922 West Owens will allow for continued progress and expansion to better serve the community.

In ending, Frazier stated that "The continued support of individuals and leaders in the community is imperative and necessary to continue its mission."
