Nevada Black Chamber of Commerce First Annual Autorama & Trade Fair Set For Aug. 31-Sept. 3

Preparations are nearing completion for the Nevada Black Chamber of Commerce's First Annual Autorama and Trade Fair to be held Aug. 31 through Sept. 3 at the Nucleus Shopping Plaza and adjacent areas.

Featured will be a community parade, auto shows with more than 35 cars, contests, trade booths and various entertainment.

The real excitement, in addition to an expensive array of classic cars and other vehicles, will be focused on the huge parade which will be routed over an extended route not witnessed before. The parade will be held at 11 a.m. on the

final day, Monday, Sept. 3 (Labor Day) starting at E.O.B. headquarters area on Comstock. It will proceed to Lake Mead to "D" Street to Jackson to "H" Street and finally to Owens, the site of the Autorama and Trade Fair.

On Friday, Aug. 31, starting at 11:30 a.m. there will be a Drill Team Contest; at 1 p.m. A Break Dance Contest and a Low Riders Contest at 2:30 p.m.

Saturday, Sept. 1 will kick off the Autorama Show and Contest starting at 12 noon. There will be a Battle of Bands Contest at 2 p.m. and then finalized at 5 p.m. with a Candidates Forum including a Ms. Chamber and Mr.

Macho contest.

The parade marshalls will be Comedian Redd Foxx and Singer Janice Carter.

Names of all finalists will be announced on Sunday, Sept. 2 at 3 p.m. and there will be a NBCC Grand Network Show Winners shown at 7 p.m. . . . all at the Nucleus Shopping Plaza.

Some of the various contests will also include a Cycle Contest, Fancy Vehicle Contest, Low Rider Contest, Van Contest, Small Truck Contest and Pleasure Boat Contest.
