cases, the homeowners provided only the paint, which amounted to approximately \$100 per home.

The Silver State Disposal Service now provides once a week pick up of all bulk trash, instead of the once a month service for this type of debris. Also, the Silver State Disposal Service will now pick up bulk trash if it is placed neatly near our regular garbage or trash areas.

We cannot say that our areas are unattractive and less viable than the other areas of Las Vegas because we have not been provided the usual services. In fact, we have been the only areas within the Las Vegas city limits receiving millions in HUD grant funds because ours were the most run down areas during this period of time.

Friends and neighbors, there really is no need for the Old West Side and Vegas Heights to yet be the less attractive areas in the Las Vegas community, less than one mile from downtown Las Vegas, the Entertainment Capital of the World, where millions of tourists from all over the world visit annually. And, our community, the Old West Side, is located closer to I-15 than any other single community within the city limits. In other words, tourists entering our fair city from the North and South see our residential areas first, before they enter the downtown area of the Strip.
